Ghost walks and t-shirt decorating at The Pantiles

This year The Pantiles is hosting spooky Ghost Walks and fun t-shirt decorating workshops as part of Kent Big Day Out, with 50 additional tickets for both events now on sale to the public for £5.

Ghoulish Ghost Walks

On Friday 27th March, ticket holders will have the chance to experience the haunting Ghost Walks at The Pantiles, hearing stories and legends of the 'ghosts' and smugglers that enrich The Pantiles' history. These walks were very popular last year and visitors are sure to be enthralled, entertained and possibly a little scared! People attending should be on their guard; they may spot the grey ladies at Binns restaurant and The Swan Hotel, or the ghost of Mary Jennings.

There will be two tours on Friday 27th March, starting at 6.30pm and 7.30pm, departing from the Corn Exchange. Guests should arrive five minutes before the tour starts. There are fifty free tickets available as part of Kent Day Out; for those who don't have a free ticket, they can be purchased for £5 from the Tourist Information Centre at The Pantiles.

Creative t-shirt painting

On Saturday 28th March there will be a series of fun t-shirt decorating workshops in the Corn Exchange. Children are invited to get creative and design their very own t-shirt with fabric marker pens, paint, fabric pastels and stencils. T-shirts will be supplied in various sizes and can be painted on both sides. Once decorated, they will be hung to dry for a short time, with each child receiving a certificate.

Children must be supervised at all times and the adult accompanying the child will receive instructions on how to wash and iron the t-shirt. The workshop is ideal for children aged between 3 and 8 years.

There are fifty free tickets available as part of Kent Day Out, with session times running at 1:30pm and 3pm. An additional 50 tickets are available and can be purchased from the Tourist Information Centre at The Pantiles for £5. These workshops will run between 11am and 2:30pm.
