**Free entertainment and dance lessons at  
FOLK ON THE PANTILES 2008**

If you're a fan of folk or up for some free dancing lessons, then head on down to the Pantiles in Tunbridge Wells on Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> July for the Folk on Pantiles weekend 2008.

This year's event will be packed full of variety. On Saturday the local Morris side, 'Royal Borough Morris' will be performing by the Tourist Information Office. They will be joined by a range of guests dancing in a great mix of styles throughout the afternoon. Performances will run between about 12pm and 4pm.

On Sunday 'Swallowtail' will begin the afternoon performing traditional folk with a bluegrass twist on the bandstand at 12pm. They'll be followed by 'Montana Rain' at 2:30pm who perform delightful country-style folk, with local dance troupe, the Pink Cadillacs, accompanying the set with some pavement line dancing.

Liz Scholey and the team from local dance company Danceon will run free dancing workshops in the Corn Exchange on the lower Pantiles from 1:15pm - 2pm, with Morris dancing on Saturday and line dancing on Sunday. "Dancing is lots of fun and I encourage people who've never danced before to take part and learn something new. Everyone is very welcome, and please arrive a few minutes early to ensure we can start on time and get the most out of it," said Liz.

The Folk on the Pantiles weekend is organised by Liz Scholey of Danceon, a local business providing line dancing, barn dancing and ceilidhs.
